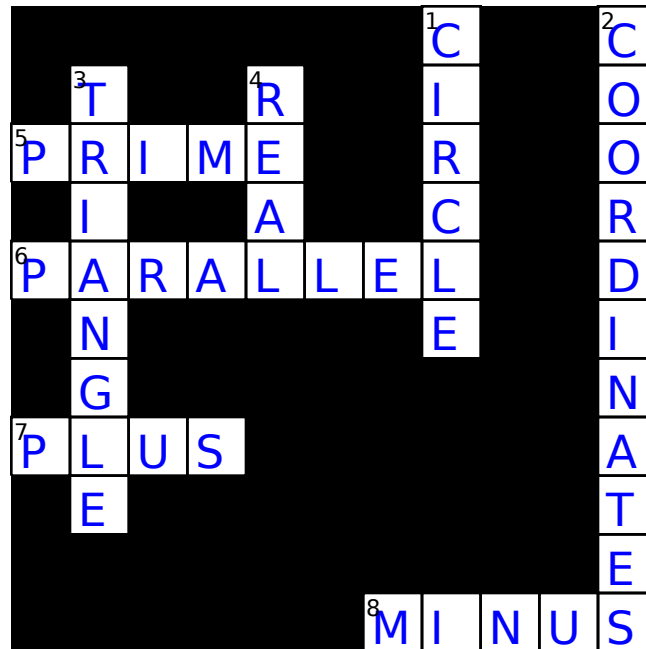


# ALGEBRAIC AND GEOMETRIC TERMS (2)

- 4 Numbers that include all the rational numbers, such as the integer  $-5$  and the fraction  $4/3$ , and all the irrational numbers, such as  $\sqrt{2}$ .
